Individual: **Top 6 in K, 1**
Participation trophies to all in Kindergarten who do not place in top 6.

Top 10 in 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 Top 6 in 7, 8 and 9-12

Medals to all players scoring 3-1/2 points or more who do not win a trophy.
Participation ribbons to all.

Team: **Top 3 in K, 1 Top 5 in 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 Top 3 in 7, 8 and 9-12**
Team score is comprised of the top 3 scores— team must have minimum of 2 players

- Players must register in their current grade level. Sections with less than 16 players may be combined if necessary. All players must be current USCF members. You may purchase or renew memberships with online payment or at the tournament.
- Late Fees: Registration fees increase effective January 3rd so register early. Registration fee January 3rd through January 7th is \$30.00. After January 7th on site registration will be required. On site registration is \$40.00 and you will receive a half-point bye for round one. Mail-in entries postmarked no later than January 7th will be accepted. Entries postmarked after January 7th will be returned and will require registration and payment at the tournament.
- All players in grades K through 9 scoring 3 or more points are automatically qualified to participate in the Arizona Scholastic State Chess Championships in April 2010. Qualification slots earned at the State Grades Championships are for corresponding sections at the AZ Scholastic State Chess Championships.
